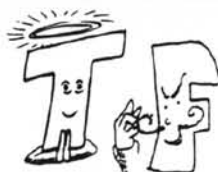

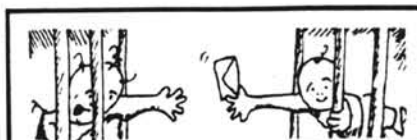
Make a **crossword fit** using any five theme words from the list. (If you've forgotten what to do, see **crossword fit** in the glossary of your S.R.B.)
