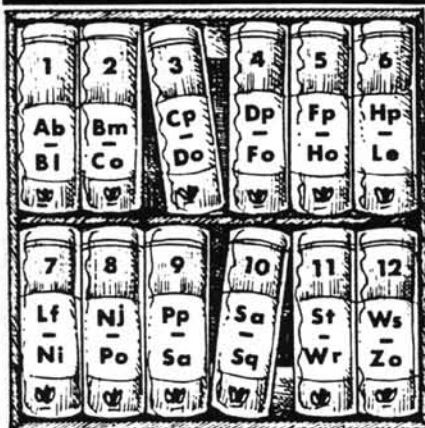

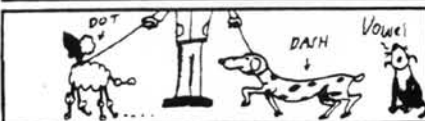


Use an atlas and the clues given, to help you name each of these **countries, cities** and/or **geographical features**.
