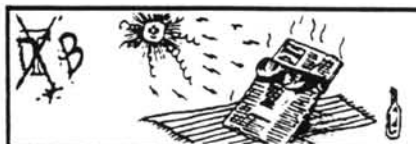


**BRAIN-BENDER'S PURSUIT**
